See below, for awareness I provided this response to Senator Tedder verbally and not in writing.

Unfortunately, we cannot provide an accurate number, and we're not able to give an estimate without a manual review of every application, which isn't possible.

• SCDMV system screens for eligibility criteria including citizenship and age and does not send information to SEC for applicants who do not meet voter eligibility criteria.

- In most cases, SCDMV employees inform applicants who are under 18 years of age at time of application that their information will not be sent to SEC, and we suggest they complete
 their voter registration with their county election office.
- On election days, SEC will contact the SCDMV in instances where a voter who was under 18 years of age and attempted to provide voter registration information through the SCDMV but is not listed as a registered voter. SCDMV will research the voter's application and inform SEC of the status to allow SEC to make a determination on whether the applicant met age requirements to register to vote, in which case SEC will allow the individual to cast a ballot.
