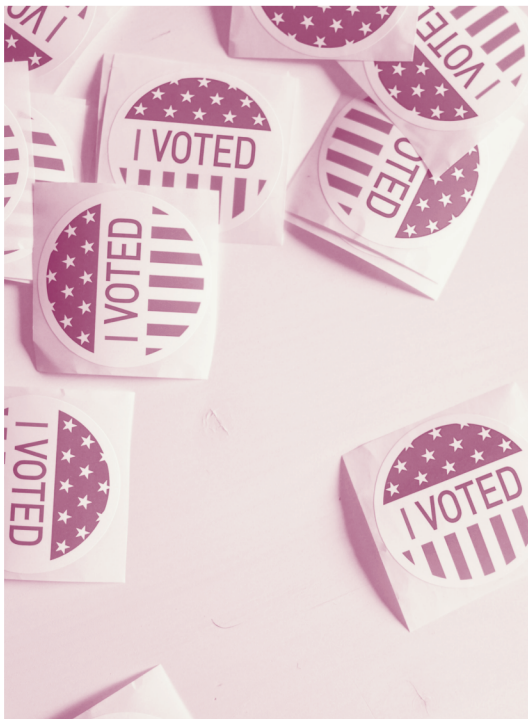


Protect Your Vote

Check Your Registration

South Carolina removed 1.2 million voters from its rolls between 2022 and 2025. **Were you one of them?** Protect your vote by checking your registration status today. **The registration deadlines for the 2026 General Election are Oct. 2 (in person), Oct. 4 (online), or Oct. 5 (by mail).**



Voter Roll Removals in South Carolina

South Carolina's population is growing, but our voter rolls are shrinking. The top reasons for voters being "purged" from the rolls include moving within a county, moving out of a county, and failing to respond to a confirmation card mailed by the state.

Black and Brown South Carolinians are losing voting power. The largest declines in registered voters happened in counties with large Black and Brown populations. Overall, there were 85,571 fewer registered voters in the state in 2025 than there were in 2022.
