Dear Applicant,

Your request for voter registration has been received by this office; however the Board of Voter Registration must determine your intention as to your official legal residence. The Federal Court and the State Attorney General have ruled that students, especially those boarded in college facilities, must meet the test of intention to move legal residence to that area. The Federal Court has allowed the following questions to be asked to determine the intention of a student as to legal residence.

Please answer the following questions, where applicable, and return in the envelope provided within ten (10) days. Failure to do so will cause automatic rejection of your application.

1. Have you registered to vote anywhere else? If so, where?
2. If you are married, in what county does your spouse have legal residence?
3. At what address in Greenville County do you keep your personal property?
4. Do you have community ties (off campus) in the area – membership in a local church, social club, service club, etc.? If so, please list.
5. Where do you have your checking or savings accounts, if any? What address do you use?
6. Where do you pay taxes, and what address did you list on your last income tax return? Do your parents claim you as a dependent? If so, in which state do they file their income taxes?

- 7. What is the address listed on your driver’s license? (State law requires a permanent address change within ten (10) days. Sec. 46-170)

- 8. If you own an automobile, at what address is it registered? (State law allows an owner thirty (30) days within which to notify the State Highway Department of an address change and obtain a corrected registration.)

- 9. If you are employed, for whom do you work and where is your job located? Is your employment “work-study” on campus?

- 10. Do you live year-round at this Greenville County claimed domicile, or do you divide it elsewhere? If it is divided, how much time is spent elsewhere and for what reason?

- 11. What residence do you list on your selective service registration, hunting or fishing licenses, insurance policies, or other official papers and documents which require a statement of residence or address?

Are there any other relevant factors or circumstances which you think should be noted that would affect the Board’s decision on your application? If so, please list.

Please answer all questions as applicable.
